White Sands FCU employees donate \$1,000 to Doña Ana County Humane Society

White Sands, NM – Thanks to the members of White Sands Federal Credit Union who purchased a ticket to the credit union’s annual meeting on April 14, a donation of \$1,000 was made to the Doña Ana County Humane society. The credit union charges its members \$5 to attend the annual dinner meeting, and donates 100 percent of the ticket sales to a community cause. The credit union also matches the amount raised from ticket sales.

The Doña Ana County Humane Society, founded in 1955, is Las Cruces' oldest animal welfare organization. They are volunteer-based and dedicated to improving the lives of companion animals in our region. They do this by working to change local rules and laws regarding animal welfare, administering programs that help get pets out of the city/county shelter and keep them with their families, promoting spay and neuter through both financial support and marketing, and educating the public about humane practices. Their goal is to bring about change and create a better world for our animal companions.
